6. CATEGORIES AND CLASSES

7. NUMBER OF RIDERS ALLOWED

The maximum number of riders allowed will be 24 (practice and race).



8. ENTRIES AND ENTRY FEE

Applications for entry must be made on the official entry form. Applications must be approved by the rider's FMN and must reach the organizer before 25.07. 2014 midnight. Applications after this date must pay € 50,00 extra entry fee per rider and can be refused. The organizer will select the applications and advise riders within 72 hours after the closing date of entries whether their applications have been accepted or rejected (by publishing the entry list on www.mini2014.eu). Riders must be in possession of a valid annual or one-event FIM-Europe Promosport license and an approval of their FMN.

The entry fee for this EC Mini road racing is € 200,00 per rider and per class.

All entry fees must be paid on the circuit at the administrative check.

There is no transponder rental fee.

The amount for the paddock facilities incl. electricity, water (with toilets/showers) and waste (no tyres or oil) is already included in the entry fee for Friday, Saturday and Sunday. Earlier arrivals (e.g. Thursday) or later departures (e.g. Monday) will be charged with € 10,00 per rider per extra day by the circuit owner.

9. ADMINISTRATIVE CHECK

The administrative checks will take place on Thursday 7. 8. 2014 from 18:00 to 20:00 and Friday 8. 8. 2014 from 07:00 to 10:00 on the 1st floor of the race-office building.

10. TECHNICAL INSPECTION

No rider or machine is permitted onto the track unless he/it has passed the technical inspections. The official technical inspections will be held on 7. 8. 2014 from 18:00 to 20:00 and Friday 8. 8. 2014 from 07:00 to 10:00. During these inspections the helmet and clothing must be presented for inspection.

11. PRACTISING

It is strictly forbidden to ride machines on the circuit outside the official practice periods according to the official time table!

Supplementary free practices on previous days (organized by the circuit owner) are not part of this event. There will be unofficial free practice on Thursday 7.8.2014 organized by the circuit owner.

12. RIDERS BRIEFING

A compulsory briefing will be held on Friday 8.8.2014 at 10:20 at the starting grid. All riders must be present and must be accompanied by a parent, guardian or team manager.

13. RACES: SCHEDULES AND DISTANCES



See enclosed schedule.

Last race will be awarded with double points according to FIM Europe rules.

14. OPENING CEREMONY

The official opening ceremony with all riders will take place on Sunday 10.08.2014 at 10:30. Only the riders + one national delegate shall gather in the pit lane with a national flag in front in front of each (country) group.

15. PRIZES

The Prize-giving ceremony will be held immediately after each race with the first three qualified riders at the podium. The final prize-giving ceremony will be held on Sunday 10.8.2014, immediately after the last race finishes at the podium.

16. PROTESTS

All protests must be made in accordance with the requirements of the FIM Europe Disciplinary and Arbitration Code and be accompanied by a fee of € 130,00.

17. FUEL

There will be no fuel supplied by the organizer in the paddock.

18. INSURANCE

By endorsing the application form for entry, the FMN of the rider certifies that the rider (or passenger) is insured in accordance with the FIM Europe requirements and declares that the rider is able to compete in the respective class.

In conformity with Art. 110.1 of the Sporting Code, third party insurance in respect of riders and passengers covering accidents occurring during the event including practices will be the responsibility of the organizer. Contract ACCR – CPP – Renomia No. 0013869817.

This insurance includes a guarantee of € 170.000.

The organizer disclaims all responsibility for damage to a motorcycle, its accessories and components arising out of an accident, fire or other cases.

19. RENUNCIATION OF ANY RECOURSE AGAINST SPORTING AUTHORITIES

Apart from the requirements of the FIM Europe Sporting Code, riders and passengers by participating, renounce all rights of appeal against the organizer, his representatives or agents by arbitration or before a tribunal or any other manner not foreseen by the FIM Europe sporting Code for any damages for which they could be liable in consequence of all acts or omissions on the part of the organizer, his officials, Representatives or agents in the application of these regulations or contributed to or arising out of their actions.
