**Q. 1 –** Marco Bolzonello welcomed everyone to the meeting and thanked everyone for work in 2015.

MB also remarked that John Collins and Pedro Mariano were also FIM Enduro Commission members and may be able to give assistance in trying to ensure as much co-operation as possible.

A Sporting Council Meeting had been held the previous day and MB gave a short report. He confirmed that the next Commission meeting could not be held after the Enduro final in Germany, but would need to be in Rome. The suggested dates were Oct 24<sup>th</sup> or Nov 7<sup>th</sup>. The date would be confirmed.

He also reported that he had asked the Management Council to consider two proposals

- a) Camera's on helmets
- b) UTV machines I Baja events

The Management Council would consider both.

He reported here had been some discussion regarding licenses costs but no firm conclusions came forward.

**Q. 2 – Minutes for Rome Commission Meeting:** These were approved

**Q. 3 – Analysis and balance of 2015 European Enduro rounds to date:**

Reports were given from:

Rd 1 - Italy. Heiko Junge was JP and reported on a very good event with good course and special tests. Organization was good, but there was concern over the number of toilets and showers provided.

Rd 2 – Croatia. Sandor Sasvari was the JP and also reported a good event. Marco Bolzonello had worked hard with the organizers and this had resulted in excellent organization. There was a very large entry proving the Championship is now very successful.

The results of both Round 1 and Round 2 were approved. The standings of the Championship to date were also approved.

**Q. 4 Enduro Regulations & Calendar 2016**

Heiko Junge drew attention to fact that in Germany there were 3 categories of National licence, and questioned which should be valid to for a European event that accepted National licences. The decision was that this was a matter for Federations to decide themselves as there was great differences involved.

It was decided that the 125cc 4 stroke category be removed

2016 Calendar: After long discussion the calendar was confirmed as

France – Brioude- FFM 26/27<sup>th</sup> March

Italy - Donoratico - FMI April 8/9<sup>th</sup>

Latvia – Ogre - LaMSF July 16/17<sup>th</sup> (will be on 23/24<sup>th</sup> July)

Holland - Harfsen- KNMV ( Final) Oct 28/29<sup>th</sup> .

The Commission were agreed the final should go to Holland, but there may be a problem if the ISDE were to be organized during Oct 2016. It was agreed to try to establish this as soon as possible. If a suitable date away from ISDE could not be found a replacement final would be introduced in (September).

In principle it was also agreed that for 2017 rounds in Portugal and Poland need some priority.

**Q. 5 Extreme Enduro Cup: Analysis and balance of events to date**

Rd 1 - UK. John Collins reported a good event with large entry, but only a small number of European riders from outside UK.

Rd 2 - Portugal - Pedro Mariano reported very good event, but only a fairly small number of riders from outside Portugal.

The results of Rd 1 & Rd 2 were approved. Two more rounds will take place . One in Sweden and one in Germany.

**Q. 6 Extreme Enduro Cup 2016. Regulations/ Calendar:**

It was agreed the format would remain the same. It was also agreed in principle to try to send an FIME Delegate/ Representative to rounds where the FMNR did not have a member on the Commission to oversee the event.

Representatives of FIME Press Office were welcomed to meeting, and they asked that the Jury President at events ensure to send them results

Also particularly in Baja, Super Enduro and Extreme a report and any photo' would also be welcomed.

The Sporting Council Chairman Mr Martin De Graaf was welcomed to the meeting along with Paola Bianchetti. Some discussion took place regarding calendar and possible problems with final in Holland clashing with ISDE.

**Q. 7 Baja's : Analysis and balance of 2015 Championship.**

Rd1 Poland - Mr Pavol Sas was JP and reported good co-operation especially with medical matters . There were not many bikes entered but a lot of Quads and UTVs

Some problems with results for Prize ceremony. The results of this round were approved

Rd 2 - Hungary ( Start in Austria) Robert Johansson reported another good event but some confusion over difference in FIM and FIME rules. Some problems with results Marco Bolzonello was present and explained that the Timekeeper had not really understood the requirements for different Championships.

The corrected results were approved.

Rd 3 Italy - Hannu Hakkala Reported only 14 FIME entries. Good organization but again difficult to get the correct classifications. Unfortunately the SR's had indicated a 450 km track and this attracted the higher entry fee, but this was reduced to 350 -400 km because of Force Majeure but higher entry fee was retained.

After some remarks the results of Italian Baja were approved.

**Q. 8 Bajas Championship 2016, Regulations and calendar**

There was great deal of discussion on suggested changes to Sporting and Technical Regulations, including proposals made by the Promoter. Marco Bolzonello would include the changes into draft regulations which would be produced to Commission in Oct/Nov meeting.

**Q. 10 Snowmobile Enduro FIM Europe Cup**

Robert Svensson gave a report of a good event. There were 63 riders including 6 Women. The results were approved.

SML will confirm a round to be held in Finland, probably on 12-13 March in Kemijarvi.

**Q. 11 Jury Presidents, Observers, Referees 2015**

Question was postpone at the next autumn meeting.

**Q. 12 Miscellaneous: Superenduro Fim Europe Cup.**

It was decided to include the above in 1 round to be organized at same time as FIM Super Enduro in Lodz Poland 5<sup>th</sup> Dec 2015.

There would be just one Open class. No class restrictions 32 entries.  
National Licence and Start Permission required from riders.  
Each FIME Federation who wished to send riders would get priority for 3 riders  
Entry fee would be 50 euro. Organizers would decide format which was suggested as 2 final  
races after qualification. In case of a tie, last race would be use as decider  
FIME would appoint a Referee.
