Other provisions:

- Cars homologated as "Kit Car" with 1400 to 1600 ccm can be accepted, if they fully match with art. 255.6.2. Weight, Appendix J
- 2WD cars and turbodiesel, whose nominal capacity is max. 2000 ccm are allowed in Gr. A and N
- Cars homologated as S1600 a S2000 are allowed to use parts of the lapsed "Erratum" without any penalty

- Honda Civic (homologation A/N 5552) is allowed to start in class 9.
- Tyres can be used according to Art. 60 of National Regulations. Cutting and warming is forbidden.

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Art. 4.6 Entry fee refunds

The entry fee shall be refunded in full

- if the event does not take place
- · to teams whose entry application is rejected

The organiser may partially refund entry fees, if a competitor cannot take part in the event due to a duly proved case of force majeure.

Art. 5. Insurance Cover

5.1 Insurance Coverage for the Organizer

- **5.1.1** The Autoclub of the Czech Republic (ACR) has made the insurance contract with Kooperativa, a. s. Viennalnsurance Group Company through the PLATINUM Consulting, s. r. o. company, a framework agreement no. 7721116973, organizer's liability insurance covering damage caused to the third party during the competition up to 10 000 000 CZK per incident.
- **5.1.2** The part of the insurance agreement is the coverage for cars against the damage caused to third party up to 10 000 000 CZK per participant. However the damage caused by drivers among themselves is not covered by this contract.

The organizer binds self to arrange this insurance contract for all competitors except those, who will show the long-term liability insurance covering damages caused on closed route.

- **5.1.3** The insurance for organizers and participants is made with an integral excess of 5 000 CZK. It means that damage up to 5 000 CZK won't be refunded and damage over 5 000 CZK will be covered without the complicity of insured.
- **5.1.4** All crews at administrative check have to hand in the valid International Green Card for their car. Without this card the crew won't be permitted to start.

5.2 Damage Reporting

The crews are obliged to notify the organizer about the damage caused on the track by their car by the end of event the latest. Violation of this duty stands for summoning the competitor and involved crew to a disciplinary committee.

5.3 Insurance Coverage Exclusions

Auxiliary vehicles, cars dedicated to reconnaissance rides and vehicles with special labels issued by the organiser are not covered by the provided rally insurance (with the exception of insured organiser's cars) and those are always going on their own responsibility.

Art. 6. Advertising and Identification

The organiser will provide each crew with the number identification (67x17cm), which must be affixed to their car in the stated positions prior to scrutineering. Each panel shall be placed horizontally at the leading edge of each front door, with the number at the front. The top of the plate shall be between 7 cm and 10 cm below the lower limit of the window. It is not allowed to cut the panel.

Art. 7. Tyres

Art. 7.1 Regulations regarding tyres which may be used during the rally

See Art. 60 of the FIA RRSR (tyres and wheels).

Art. 7.2 Tyres for use on reconnaissance

At all times during the event in the Czech Republic, the tread depth of the tyres fitted on the car, must not be less than 1.6 mm.

Art. 7.3 National laws or special requirements

At all times during the event in the Czech Republic, the tread depth of the tyres fitted on the car, must not be less than 1.6 mm.

Art. 8. Fuel

All type of fuel must follow Appendix J Art. 252.9. (RRSR Art. 59).

Art. 9. Reconnaissance of Special Stages

Reconnaissance will be according to FIA RRSR Art. 25. The schedule for the reconnaissance is published in Appendix 2 of these supplementary regulations.

Art. 9.1 Registration procedure

Recce cars must be registered with a separate form.

Each car must be identified with a reconnaissance car number supplied by the organiser. Rally cars used in the event may not be used for reconnaissance.

Starting number must be affixed in right upper part of the windscreen and in both rear side windows during reconnaissance at all the times.

This identification does not grant an entrance to the service park. Immediately after the reconnaissance these numbers have to be removed from the car.

Art. 9.2 Specific regulations

During reconnaissance, all national traffic regulation must be followed, including but not limited to the speed limits. Please note that the Special Stages will not be closed to public traffic during reconnaissance. The organizer may reduce the allowed speed individually by marking the areas in the road book and along the route. Speeding during reconnaissance and / or shakedown will penalised according to FIA RRSR Article 20.2.

Two months before the rally holds the FIA RRR Art. 11.2. Crews that have performed reconnaissance before closing the registration, the organizing committee rejects the entry. Crews that have performed reconnaissance outside the official period after the application deadline, the director refuses to start, and the deposit will not be refunded to them.

During two months before the rally starts it is forbidden to drive any competition or other team car (besides the recce car during the reconnaissance). For breaking this rule bear full responsibility, the competitor (the CoC refuses the start of this crew).

Passing the Special Stage route

There are allowed maximum two passages of the same special stage (except for SS 1 Valašské Meziříčí – městská and SS 10/14 Juřinka).

For the Czech Rally Championship holds the Art. 25.5.1 of National Regulations 2019.

SS 1 Valašské Meziříčí – city stage: the reconnaissance will be performed according to issued schedule (crews will get the schedule at the Presentation) in group behind the Organizer's vehicle. Times of the reconnaissance will be issued together with the list of entries.

SS 10/14 Juřinka: there is allowed only one passage of the stage any time during the period for the reconnaissance.

Crews can enter the stage only in SS START and leave it only in SS FINISH.

Driving in the opposite direction is forbidden except for areas marked in Appendix 2 of these SR. Crews are obliged to follow all the regulations of art. 20.2 and 25 in National Regulations and these SR.

Art. 9.3 Collection of speed control checking devices

All reconnaissance cars must be equipped with a speed control checking devise. This devise can be collected according the programme in chronological order (SR Art. 3)

Crews are obliged to return the device to the organizer before the end of Administrative checks.

Any later return of the device will be penalized with fine of 1.000 CZK (40 EUR). In case of device loss the crew will compensate the device value with 3.630 CZK without VAT (146 EUR).

Art. 10. Administrative checks

Art. 10.1 Documents to be presented:

To keep the time required for the administrative checks to the necessary minimum, make sure to bring and present the following documents:

- Completion of all details on the entry form and Technical card
- Competitors' licence
- Driver's and co-driver's competition licences
- Driver's and co-driver's valid driving licences
- ASN authorisation for foreign competitors (if required)
- Car insurance cover certificate
- Car registration papers

Art. 11. Scrutineering, Sealing and Marking

Art. 11.1 Scrutineering, venue and time

Cars may be presented at scrutineering by a representative of the team.

Venue: AUTOCENTRUM LUKÁŠ, Masarykova 752, Valašské Meziříčí,

Date and Time: Friday 29.03.2019 08:00 h - 14:00 h

Art. 11.1.1 Scrutineering, mandatory documents

- Cars' complete certified homologation
- SOS / OK board (DIN A3 format)

For each car of the **FIA Priority Drivers**, one spare gearbox and one set of spare differentials (front and/or centre and/or rear) may be used in each rally. These spare components and those fitted to the car will be marked/sealed at initial scrutineering. These cars must have their sump guards removed for sealing of gearboxes and differentials and be kept with the car for the purpose of weighting.

The installation of the tracking system will be checked at scrutineering.

Art. 11.1.2 Timetable for scrutineering

See programme (SR Art. 3)

Detailed schedule will be publish together with the publishing of List of Entries

Art. 11.2 Mud flaps

See ISC Appendix J, Article 252.7.7

Art. 11.3 Windows

See ISC Appendix J, Article 253.11

Art. 11.4 Drivers' safety equipment

All items of clothing including helmets and FHR (Front Head Restraint) intended to be used, e.g. HANS devices, must be presented for scrutineering. They shall be checked for compliance with Appendix L, Chapter III.

Art. 11.5 Noise level

All cars must always be equipped with an exhaust silencer.

The noise level on the open road must not exceed 96 dB(A) for with allowed tolerance of +2 dB(A) for instrumental error. The measuring is proceeded at engine rotation speed of 3500 rpm for petrol engines and 2500 rpm for diesel engines according to EHK 51.02 Regulations. The noise level will be checked during scrutineering and may be proceeded also during the rally. Exceeding the noise level limit will lead to refusing the start of the crew in the rally. Exceeding the noise level limit during the rally will be reported to the Stewards who can apply sanctions according to Art. 12.1 and 12.2 ISC.

Art. 11.6 Special national requirements

All vehicles according to Art. 4.3.2 SR have to comply with Czech law No. 56/2001 Sb. with exceptions for sporting vehicles.

Art. 11.7 Installation of the GPS safety tracking system ONI®

All participants of rallies in the Czech Republic will get their cars equipped with a GPS monitoring device $\mathsf{ONI}^@$. Detailed information will be specified during the collection of materials.

After arrival to the scrutineering, device administrator will install the tracking unit, antenna and control panel to the vehicle.

Date and time: Friday 29.03.2019 from 7:30 h.

Place: Valašské Meziříčí, Masarykova 752, AUTOCENTRUM LUKÁŠ

At the end of the rally or after retirement, the tracking unit or complete tracking system must be returned to the device administrator. Usually the devices are collected in the last service area or before finish of the rally.

Fees:

Tracking unit 110 CZK (included in Entry fee)

Complete set (tracking unit, antenna, control panel) 350 CZK or 15 €

Refundable deposit (deposited with ONI® administrator) licence or 1 000 CZK or 41 €

Eventual destruction, non-return or damage of the unit has to be paid for by the competitor to the provider in accordance with the applicable price list.

Every attempt to falsify, manipulate or infringe the tracking device, which will make impossible to collect data because of external interference will be reported to the Stewards who can penalize the crew up to exclusion from the event.

Art. 12. Other procedures and regulations

Art. 12.1 Ceremonial start procedure and order

Crews will come to the ceremonial start in order to the schedule. The times of the ceremonial start will be given to the crews together with the times of scrutineering.

Racing overalls are not compulsory, there is recommended team wear.

Where a crew is unable to participate in the ceremonial start with its competing car because of damage suffered during Shakedown, it shall be reported to the Competitors" relations officer. Still the crew is obliged to participate in the ceremony without the car.

The ceremonial start will be proceeded in given order on the start ramp with national flag as follows:

 5 seconds prior to the start time the flag will be raised to the horizontal level and at the start time waved above.

Art. 12.1.1 Start of Special Stages (except for circuit SS)

The start to special stages will be given by an electronic digital countdown system, counting down by seconds and clearly visible to the crew from the start position and electronically coupled to a start line detection device that records any situation when a car leaves the start line ahead of the correct signal. The start is with car standing with its front part on the level of the start line.

Light signals combined with digital countdown system will be used:

- 39 sec. red light switches on
- 30 sec. the starter shows on the starting countdown system,
- 10 sec. red light blinks on,
- 0 sec. START, green light switches on,
- - 20 sec. green light switches off, red light switches on, the Art. 37.4.3 of the FIA Regional regulations will be applied.

Art. 12.1.2 Circuit Special Stages 1 Valašské Meziříčí and SS 10/14 Juřinka

The assumed time of the start will be marked in the Time Card after the crew arrives. This gives the beginning of time to the next TC. Start will not be in top of the minute, entry to the stage will be managed by Timekeeper (using the light signals). If the start will be in the expected time interval (about 1 minute), the timekeeper shows table with number (5 five seconds before the green switch on). The crew start the SS when the timekeeper gives them the sign, the stage is free and the green light switches on. The exact start time will be recorded by the photocell.

If the time to the start will be longer than 1 minute, it can be assumed that timekeeper shows the crew table STOP and then table with number 5 five seconds before the green light switch on.

If the red light is on, it is forbidden to start to the stage. The crew will be reported to the Stewards.

Art. 12.1.3 Restart after retirement

A crew which fails to finish Leg 1 of the rally will be permitted to restart the next Leg. For new start the conditions according to the art. 46 National Regulations have to be followed. Scrutineering after repair will be done in the Parc Fermé before the Start of Leg 2 on 31.03.2019 at 06:45.

Art. 12.2 Finish procedures

The rally ends in TC at the entrance to the holding area before the finish ramp. There will be prepared a podium for the first three crews (absolute). Other prizes (Art. 14 SR) will be handed over on the ramp. After the ceremonial the crews are obliged to go straight to the Parc Fermé.

Art. 12.3 Permitted early check-in

Early-check is permitted in: TC 1A – Finish of Leg 1, Section 1 TC 8C – Finish of Leg 1 TC 14A – Rally Finish

Art. 12.4 Special Stages

12.4.1 Shakedown

- The crew have to be registered for shakedown (see art. 3 SR).
- The number of passes is not limited; however the entrance to the shakedown is limited by time (see art. 3 SR).
- Registration fee for the shakedown is 1.210 CZK (49 EUR).
- Only competitors, who passed administrative check and scrutineering, can participate in Shakedown. Competition numbers and advertising stickers must be affixed to their cars. It is compulsory to wear the safety equipment of driver and co-driver as for normal SS.
- For the Shakedown if there is in the car a person, by exception, not rally participant, this person must have an approval from the Clerk of the Course and this person must together with the competitor declare and sign a disclaimer of responsibility the form will be available at the administrative check and the Shakedown start.

12.4.2 Circuit Special Stage 1 Valašské Meziříčí

- In circuit stage is the same section run several times. After start of the SS the crew continues on the circuit stage according to the road book. After first lap the crew leaves the circuit and continues to the flying finish. After passing the finish line they have to reach the STOP control, where they stop and hand over the time card. The result of the SS does not have to be given to the crews immediately; it will be announced by the end of the section at the latest. After leaving the circuit (between the FINISH and STOP sign) the crew is not allowed to stop and put other crews in danger.
- The crew, which fails to complete the SS 1 or retires during Section 1, will receive a notional time of 10 minutes. This time will be given also to crews which will reach worse time in the stage, and also to crews which will do lower than prescribed number of laps. Retired crew can restart in the Leg1, Section 2. For new start the conditions according to the art. 46 National Regulations have to be followed. The car has to be present in the Parc Ferme 1 hour before the start of Leg 1, Section 2 and will undergo new scrutineering.
- Exceeding the prescribed number of rounds for more than 2 laps will be reported to the Stewards.
- The crews which are given a red flag sign continue with reduced speed to the exit of the circuit
 and then continue to the STOP immediately. The CoC gives them a notional time in accordance
 with art. 39 FIA RRSR.
- The judge of fact who counts the rounds will be on start of the SS.
- Failure to comply with the rules for circuit SS will be reported to the Stewards.

12.4.3 Circuit Special Stage 10/14 Juřinka

- In circuit stage is the same section run several times. After start of the SS the crew continues on the circuit stage according to the road book. After first lap the crew leaves the circuit and continues to the flying finish. After passing the finish line they have to reach the STOP control, where they stop and hand over the time card. The result of the SS does not have to be given to the crews immediately, it will be announced by the end of the section at the latest. After leaving the circuit (between the FINISH and STOP sign) the crew is not allowed to stop and put other crews in danger.
- The crew, which fails to complete the prescribed number of laps, will receive a penalty of 6 minutes to their time for each incomplete lap. The crew which does more laps than the prescribed number, will be given the real time for all laps.
- Exceeding the prescribed number of rounds for more than 2 laps will be reported to the Stewards.
- The crews which are given a red flag sign, continue with reduced speed to the exit of the circuit and then continue to the STOP immediately. The CoC gives them a notional time in accordance with art. 39 National Regulations.
- The judge of fact who counts the rounds will be on start of the SS.
- Failure to comply with the rules for circuit SS will be reported to the Stewards.

12.4.4 Barriers (chicanes)

Due to safety reasons, chicanes will be placed on the rally route. The Judges of fact will be published on the official notice board.

Any crew which passes the chicane incorrectly will receive a penalty by CoC:

• moving (overturn) 1 part of the chicane outside its base

5 sec 30 sec

skipping the chicane

The Stewards decide in disputed cases.

Art. 12.5 Special procedures and activities

Art. 12.5.1 Service park organization

A limitation for servicing and service park is introduced in National Regulations (especially art. 2.15 and art. 48 - 50) and this SR.

Allocation of working area – team areas (FIA ERT, MČR)

- Priority drivers FIA and ASN will be allotted an area of ca. 100 m², other crews ca. 80 m². Allotted place will be announced to the crews during the presentation and the plan of the service park will be on Official Notice Board and organizer's website.
- Crews can order a Commercial pack + 50 m² (see Art. 4.5.2.1)
- Crews can in the entry form ask for the smaller area of 60 m² and pay reduced entry fee.
- Special requests (location, enlarge the area for a fee of 100 CZK/m² or other services) have to be delivered in written form by the deadline of entries at the latest.
- Special requests after this deadline are cost 2.420 CZK.

Driving in service park - Test area TATRA Kopřivnice

• Maximum speed allowed in the service park is 30 km/h. Exceeding this speed limit will be penalized according to Art. 49.4 FIA RRR.

Entrance and parking of the service cars in the service park

- The service park Test area TATRA Kopřivnice may by enterer only by cars with sticker SERVICE or AUXILIARY supplied by the organizer and by the competition cars. These vehicles can be parked only in the allocated competitor's area.
- Any vehicle without SERVICE or AUXILIARY label found in the service park bing parked outside of any team area will be towed away from the service park at the expenses of the owner to the paid parking lot.

Other Service park provisions

- Trailers have to be parked in dedicated area near the service park.
- It is strictly forbidden to damage the surface in the service park e.g. with drilling holes for anchors, using paints etc.
- Service place in service park will be handed over and taken back by chief of service, who control the cleanness.

For breaking the rules in service park, CoC can penalize the crew with fine up to 5.000 CZK. Serious offences will be reported to the Stewards.

Art. 12.5.2 Availability of participants

Participants who park their vehicles in the Parc Fermé upon passing the finish line, must remain available by phone (mobile) until the final classification have been posted.

Art. 12.5.3 Classification

The official final classification will not be distributed after the event. The final classification will be published on the website on the Digital Notice Board at www.valasskarally.cz.

Art. 12.6 Official time used during the rally

Official time of the rally is the radio time in 92,5 MHz ČRo 1 - Radiožurnál.

If a protest requires the dismantling and re-assembly of a clearly defined part of the car, any additional deposit will be specified by the Stewards upon a proposal of the Chief Scrutineer.

The appeal deposit for an national appeal is: **CZK 22.000** The appeal deposit for an international appeal is: **EUR 3.000**

All protests and/or appeals must be lodged in accordance with Articles 13 and 15 of the Code and, where applicable, with the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules.



Appendix 5 – Extracts from FIA ISC Appendix L relating to overalls, helmets and any other safety requirements

1. Flame-resistant clothing

In rally special stages must all drivers and co-drivers wear overalls as well as gloves (optional for co-drivers), long underwear, a balaclava, socks and shoes homologated to the FIA 8856-2000 standard (Technical List N° 27). See art. 6.1. chapter E of National Regulations.

2. Helmets

In rally special stages must all drivers and co-drivers wear helmets with the FIA standards and listed in FIA technical sheet no. 25 (www.fia.com).

3. Frontal Head Restraint (FHR e.g. HANS®)

According to article 3, chapter III Appendix of FIA RRR is the Frontal Head Restraint obligatory for all drivers and co-drivers. Homologated FHR systems are listed in the FIA Technical List N°29 according to FIA 8858 standard. FHR must be used only with element approved by the FIA (article 3.2, chapter III Appendix L of FIA RRR).

4. Safety belts

Drivers and co-drivers must be fasten throughout the driving (SS and rally track) in the seats with safety belts which are approved by specification of Appendix J (art. 4, chapter III Appendix L of FIA RRR). According to art.253/6.1 Appendix J must be all cars equipped with safety belts with homologation FIA 8853/98. It is strongly recommended to use safety belts equipped with lock type "P" /push-button/ with pushing mechanism. In the car must be permanently two knives on belts. They must be easily accessible for driver and co-driver in their seats with seat belts fastened.

5. Drivers safety equipment card

Appendix 6 - MONITORING GPS SYSTEM ONI®

1. General provisions

All competition cars have to be obligatorily equipped with the ONI® tracking system. ONI® tracking system is owned by the Autoclub of the Czech Republic and will be rented to the competitors (for non-refundable fee 350 CZK or 15 EUR payable by competitor). Eventual destruction, non-return or damage of the unit has to be paid for by the competitor to the provider in accordance with the applicable price list. In case of non-returning GPS tracking system immediately after the event, the fine 600 euro will be imposed to the competitor.

2. Distribution of the ONI® tracking system

ONI® tracking system contains following parts:

- tracking unit with display
- tracking unit holder
- power supply cable
- combined antenna roof
- control panel containing:
 - OK button to cancel the alarm / confirm red flag
 - SOS switch for calling emergency



ONI[®] tracking system will be installed to every rally car before each event. Detailed information will be published no later than during roadbooks issuing.

After arrival to the scrutineering, device administrator will install the tracking unit, antenna and control panel. Antenna and power supply cables can be purchased by the crew for personal ownership.

At the end of the rally or after retirement, the tracking unit or complete tracking system must be returned to the device administrator. Usually the devices are collected in the last service area or before finish of the rally.

3. Installation of the unit in the car

- 3.1 To fit the tracking unit with display, antenna and control panel, it is necessary for the competitor to follow exactly the Installation guide, to keep the unit in good condition and to protect it against damage and fouling (especially the connectors) during the time.
- 3.2 Foreign and one time rally participants will receive a rental version of the set equipped with magnetic roof antenna.
- 3.3 Control panel with OK button and SOS switch is in one box for which the competitor has to choose a suitable place for fitting within the reach of both crew members. It is obliged to prepare everything for its installation prior to the scrutineering.

4. The unit operation during rally

To operate the unit, the crews have to meet all instructions as mentioned in the User's guide.

Operation during events on SS:

Accident (crash detection)

- The unit evaluates the situation and sends info about accident to rally control. Crew cannot affect this message.
 - The display shows message: **Are you OK?** Confirm.
 - 10 s after this question, the siren wails for next 15 s
- If the crew pushes **OK** button, this information is sent to rally control and information about accident is not sent to the unit of following cars in the stage.

Stop in SS

- When the car stops in SS, it is counted as an obstacle. Unit signals to the crew by sound siren and text, that they have stopped. This signal takes 15 s.
- If the crew doesn't push OK, warning message is sent to the rally control and also to other cars, which are currently in the stage arriving to the obstacle.
- With pushing the OK button the crew confirms that they are okay, on the display is shown message OK and information about obstacle is not send to the unit of next cars in the stage.

Request for help

- Changing the switch is confirmed by SOS message on display, also the siren sounds.
- The siren sound can be cancelled by pushing OK button.

· Red flag

- When the rally control hangs out the red flag, the display shows big message RED FLAG (with red background) and the siren sounds.
 - Crew has obligation to confirm receiving the red flag by pushing the OK button and to reduce the speed according to the sporting regulations.
 - The siren sound can be cancelled by pushing OK button.
 - The red flag on display can be cancelled only by rally control.

5. Speed checking during reconnaissance

During reconnaissance the crew is obliged to follow traffic rules of the Czech Republic. Not respecting this rules, especially exceeding the speed limits, will be monitored via ONI® tracking system. This checking doesn't exclude other checks, i.e. police controls according to their standard procedures.

ONI® tracking system for reconnaissance

Tracking system is checking the speed in every moment during the reconnaissance.

Every crew will pick up the ONI® recce tracking unit together with roadbook. Installation of the unit and its using during reconnaissance is obligatory for all crews during the whole schedule of reconnaissance according to the art. 3 Reconnaissance schedule. For speed checking during the reconnaissance, NCL 21 units are used.



NCL21 unit is started during roadbook issuing before starting of reconnaissance. For whole reconnaissance the unit is working on its own battery. It is not necessary to plug the unit to any power supply.

It is possible to place the unit on metal surfaces - magnets are implemented in the unit.

Not using the unit in a rally car during reconnaissance will be fined.

Every attempt to falsify, manipulate or infringe the unit for reconnaissance or any device, which will make impossible to collect data because of external interference will be reported to the stewards who can penalize the crew up to refusing the start.

Decision regarding seriousness of the offence and its repeating is in Clerk of the Course's authority. For exceeding the speed limit, sanctions can be given according to supplementary regulations or championship regulations.
